The Barnet Planning/Zoning Board will hold a public hearing in the conference room of the Town Clerk's office at 7:00 p.m. on June 5, 2018 to consider the following proposed up dated Barnet Zoning Bylaw. This proposed Bylaw replaces the Barnet Zoning Ordinance Adopted in 1983 and last amended in 1997.

The whole Bylaw was updated and applies to the whole Town of Barnet.

The primary purpose of the proposed zoning Bylaw is to correct references to the State Statue, expand flood plain regulations to conform to FEMA recommendations, to expand conditional uses in some districts and clarify some definitions.

All Changes made conform to our Municipal Plan, including the effect on safe and affordable housing. Revisions considered future land uses and densities of the Municipal Plan. No planned community facilities are impacted.
