

Be it ordained by the Selectmen of the Town of
Barnet as follows:

The following Sections are added to Chapter 2
of the Ordinances of the Town of Barnet:

Sec. 9. The speed limit of motor vehicles on
any street or highway within the limits of the Town of
Barnet, shall be governed according to the posted speed
limits within each zone.

Sec. 10. No person shall throw or dump ashes,
waste paper, hand bills, circulars, rubbish or refuse of
any sort upon or in any public street, highway, public park,
monument or cemetery or part thereof within the Town of
Barnet.

Sec. 11. No person shall defile, damage or
destroy any public monument, public building or cemetery
within the Town of Barnet.

Sec. 12. No person shall discharge a firearm
within the heavily populated areas of the Town of Barnet,
which said populated areas shall consist of Barnet Village,
West Barnet Village, East Barnet Village, Passumpsic
Village and McIndoes Falls.

Sec. 13. Any person violating Sec. 9, Sec. 10,
Sec. 11, or Sec. 12 of this Ordinance shall be fined not
more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

The foregoing ordinances were passed, enacted and adopted
by unanimous affirmative vote of the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Barnet, Vermont, at a meeting duly called
and held at the Town Clerk's Office in the Town of Barnet
on the 27th day of October A.D. 1970, to become effective

sixty days from the last mentioned date, and it was ordered by said Board of Selectmen that said Ordinances be published in the Caledonian Record not more than fourteen days following the 27th day of ~~June~~, 1970.
