

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF BARNET AS  
FOLLOWS:

THAT SEC. 1 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN  
OF BARNET ADOPTED ON JUNE 15, 1970 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO  
READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Sec. 1. The public beach, bathing area and parking  
lot in the Town of Barnet shall be opened to the public  
during hours established by the Board of Selectmen,  
pursuant to duly adopted Resolution, which said  
Resolution shall be entered in the Minutes of the  
Selectmen's Meeting and duly posted in at least one  
conspicuous location in the vicinity of the public  
beach, bathing area and parking lot. No persons other  
than the maintenance person or lifeguard shall enter  
upon or make use of the public beach or parking lot  
during hours when the same are closed to the public."
