

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF BARNET  
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT THE SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE SAID  
SELECTMEN ON THE 20TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1977 IS HEREBY  
AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Selectmen of the Town of Barnet have determined on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that maximum speed limits permitted by State law are greater than is reasonable and safe under conditions found to exist on the Town Roads of Barnet; and

WHEREAS, they wish to establish maximum speed limits to provide reasonable and safe conditions upon said Town Roads;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Selectmen do hereby enact speed limit ordinances as follows:

1. The following public highways or portions of public highways within the Town of Barnet are hereby designated 35 m.p.h. speed zones. Any person who operates a motor vehicle in such 35 m.p.h. speed zone at a rate of speed in excess of 35 m.p.h. shall be fined in accordance with Title 23 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated. The highways above referred to are as follows:

SA #1	From west side of I91 to jct. with TH #62 in West Barnet
SA #2	From jct. with SA #1 to Peacham Town line
SA #3	From one-half mile easterly of U. S. Route 5 to Waterford line



SA #1 From TH #62 to Peacham Town line  
SA #3 From U. S. Route #5 easterly  
one-half mile  
TH #12 From Jct. with TH #11 to Jct.  
with TH #14; also northerly from  
Jct. with SA #3 to Jct. with  
TH #106  
TH #60 From Jct. with TH #61 northerly  
.2 mile  
TH #61 From Jct. with SA #1 northerly  
.4 mile  
TH #74 From Jct. with SA #1 southerly  
to Jct. with TH #75  
TH #81 From Jct. with SA #1 easterly  
.3 mile

Entire Length: Town Highway #9, 10, 11, 13, 31, 57, 58,  
59, 62, 69, 71, 72, 73, 76, 97, 98, 99,  
100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107,  
and 109.
