Chairman, McLam called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. and moved to item 1. Public request to address the Board by Mary Jane Egerton. She had handed out information to the Board about short term rentals, including Bylaws from other Towns. She also read a letter explaining why she think Barnet needs regulations

Bowen asked if this was proper because of the Lawson law suite. The Board felt short term rentals had nothing to do with that.
