The Barnet Selectboard will perform its annual review of the town's Ordinance for Regulating All-Terrain Vehicles at its first regular meeting following Annual Town Meeting, pursuant to the Ordinance. The regular meeting will be warned separately.

Included in this review will be the consideration of which town highways or portions thereof ATV travel will be permitted upon during the 2024 season.

Town highways under consideration include: Anderson St, Barnet Center Rd, Bony Woods Rd, Brook Hill Rd, Chamberlain Rd, Cloud Brook Rd, Ferguson Rd, Garland Hill Rd, Gilfillan Rd, Goss Hill Rd, Joe's Brook Rd, Keyser Hill Rd, Knights Ln, Little Scotland Rd, McLaren Hill Rd, Morse's Mill Rd, Roy Mountain Rd, Water Andric Rd, West Barnet Rd, West Main St, and Whitehill Rd. Proposed 2024 town highway access is the same as was approved in 2023.
