

FLOOD SPECIFIC DEBRIS REMOVAL-BARNET

Items that were specifically contaminated by flood waters in your home or business will be collected by the State of Vermont. If your home or business was flooded, items such as couches, beds, chairs, etc. may be placed in the public right of way (25' from the center line of a public road). If you do so, you must call the Barnet Fire Station at 633-3800 and leave your name, address and location of placed items so we can have them removed by the State in a coordinated manner.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Barnet Town Garage is hosting the hazardous waste drop off site to the left of the garage. Items must be placed on the tarp. Leaking vessels must be first placed in a bin, then on the tarp. Items include: White goods(such as dishwashers, dryers, refrigerators, water heaters), toxic chemicals, pesticides, oil, brake cleaners, electronics, batteries and lightbulbs, paint, stain, tires, propane and gas cylinders, and mercury products.

VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

If you have acquired vegetative debris on your property from the flooding, it is your responsibility to cut it into an arm-manageable size for the state to pick it up. It also **MUST** be placed in the public right of way (25' from the center line of the public road) and must be reported to the Barnet Fire Station at 633-3800 with your name, address and location of items so we can coordinated with the State for pickup.

The Barnet Transfer Station will be open Saturday. However, please be conscious of the fact that it will be busy. If you can wait to go to the Transfer Station and were not directly affected by the flood, please consider those that were and their need to rid their property of flood-soaked items. The TS will be open Wednesday, July 24th for garbage only. The recycling will NOT, as requested by Casella.
