- 2. **Barnet Town Library-** 147 Church St. 10-2 pm, Wi-Fi, refreshments, couch, (Accessible bathroom)
- 3. **Barnet Historical Society's Goodwillie House Museum** Goodwillie Rd. Open House and guided tours: 10 4 pm. This 3-story building is the oldest wood frame house in town, built in the early 1790s. (Bathroom available for visitors)
- 4. **Ben's Mill 2236 W. Barnet Rd.** 11 3pm. This historic water- powered wheelwright and carriage shop, cider mill, blacksmith forge and fix-it shop will be open for tours. On Saturday, they have a fund-raiser Rubber Ducky Race, (ducks swim at 11, with a food truck. Porta-potty on site.
