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NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF PARKING ORDINANCE

On 13 July 2026 the Selectboard of the Town of Barnet, Vermont, adopted a Parking Ordinance pursuant to 4 V.S.A. § 32(c)(11); 19 V.S.A. §§ 304(a)(6), 1105; 23 V.S.A. §§ 1008, 1102; 2151 et seq.; 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59; 24 V.S.A. § 2291(4), (26); and Vermont Rule of Civil Procedure 80.9. This notice is published pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1972 to inform the public of this Ordinance adoption and of the citizens' right to petition.

CITIZENS' RIGHT TO PETITION FOR VOTE

Title 24 V.S.A. § 1973 grants citizens the right to petition for a vote at a special or annual Town Meeting to disapprove the Ordinance adopted by the Selectboard. To exercise this right, citizens must present to the Selectboard or the Town Clerk a petition for a vote on the question of disapproving the Ordinance adoption signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the Town's qualified voters. The petition must be presented within forty-four (44) days following the date of the adoption of the Ordinance. Unless a petition requesting a vote is filed pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the Parking Ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of said adoption.
